Our Mission Statement

What is asked of you?

1. Bring a diaper bag with diapers, wipes, and a sippy cup.
2. Please make sure all items and diaper bag are labeled.
3. Please be sure your child been healthy for the previous 24 hours.
4. Sign your child in and take your Pick-Up Authorization Tag.

General Information

1. The nursery will be open 15 minutes prior to Sunday School and church services.
2. The nursery will remain open between Sunday School and the church service. You will no longer need to take your child between SS and the service. Please refrain from visiting your child, as it may cause unnecessary upset or your child or others.
3. All children must be signed in on the sheet at the gate. Parents will be given a Pick-Up Authorization tag. We must have this to release your child from our care.

Diaper Bag

1. Please bring a labeled diaper bag.
2. What to include: labeled sippy cup, diapers, wipes, and extra clothes.
3. Please **DO NOT** send snack with your child. Faith will provide allergy-friendly snacks, and we do not want any cross contamination.

Thank you for your help in keeping the children with allergies safe!



Well-Child Policy

1. Children who are sick (fever, vomiting or diarrhea within the previous 24 hours, skin rash, pink eye, etc) will not be allowed in the nursery.
2. If your child develops symptoms while in the nursery, a volunteer will let you know during the service and you will be asked to retrieve your child at that time.
3. No medication will be administered in the nursery.
4. Parents should alert the nursery of allergies on the Child Registration form.

Snack Time

1. If your child has a food allergy, please let the nursery staff know. We will do everything we can to accommodate the allergy.
2. Snacks will be provided by Faith, and are approved for all children attending morning nursery. The snacks are all NUT FREE, mango and strawberry free, and conscious of milk products.

Again, please DO NOT send food into the nursery. We do not want to take any chance that a child with life-threatening allergies will be harmed.

Nursery Staff Member

We have a full-time staff member who will be in our church nursery every Sunday! She attends Saint Bernadette in Amelia. She just graduated from OU with her Early Childhood Education degree, and loves working with young children. We are very excited to have her in our nursery. Please let her know if you need anything at all!

Nursery Staff will be leading a simple, age-appropriate curriculum on Sunday mornings. This will introduce the children to a structured story time at church, and teach simple bible stories using songs, puppets, and books.
